The programme has been designed for administrative and academic staff of Rennes 2 University partners, with priority given to universities of the [EMERGE](#) Alliance but applications from other partners will also be considered.

OUR OFFER:

1. Improve your French language skills with Rennes 2's premier language-learning center, the CIREFE;
2. Gain a greater understanding of the French culture;
3. Take part in numerous cultural outings.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION:

- **Dates:** from Monday, 22nd to Friday, June 26th, 2026
- **Venue:** [Université Rennes 2](#), Villejean Campus, Rennes (Brittany)
- **Cost and fees:** 350 € without accomodation;

Participants from ERASMUS+ universities can apply, in their own universities, for a ERASMUS+ grant to support these costs.

This fee will include:

- 16 hours of French-language and civilisation courses
- A one-day excursion to the coastal city of Saint Malo
- Wine and cheese tasting evening
- Guided visit of the city-centre of Rennes
- Museum visit with a tour guide
- Welcome lunch, closing lunch, announced coffee breaks
- Local travel (10 metro / bus tickets)

This fee will not include:

- Travel expenses;
- Accommodation fees and meal costs except Monday and Friday lunches.

- **Minimum level of French required: Confirmed A2 level** (a preliminary online language test will be proposed to help determine the level of each selected participant).

- **Registration is available online until Monday March 16th, 2026:** [registration form](#)
 - The number of participants is limited to **20 persons maximum** and we will not be able to accept more than 2 people per institution;
 - All applicants, including those who are not selected, will receive the **results of the selection** by email by no later than **Friday, April 3rd, 2026**.
